## Our Package

We help schools meet duties under Equalities Act 2010 and new Ofsted Framework Literacy, PSHE & SEAL curriculum.

New duties under the Equalities Act 2010 require all schools to publish detail of the equalities work they are doing. Cric!Crac! can help schools to meet these requirements. The package also fulfills parts of the new Ofsted Framework. All of this whilst covering areas of the Literacy, PSHE & SEAL curriculum! Sessions can be linked into specific learning journeys or topics such as space/explorers or be timed with yearly topical events such as Black History Month or Anti-bullying week.
